1999 MEETING OF THE SOCIETY OF CARIBBEAN ORNITHOLOGY

The twelfth annual meeting of the Society of Caribbean Ornithology will take place in Santo Domingo, Dominican Republic, 30 July to 4 August 1999. The main workshop will concern environmental education, with an emphasis on target audiences other than teachers; e.g., park guards, farmers, fishermen, military personnel, community leaders, or decision makers. Participants will be asked to bring any and all educational materials or resources available which will serve as the base of an information resource clearinghouse, as suggested during last year's workshop.

In addition, the West Indian Whistling-Duck Working Group will be presenting a wetlands education workbook and conducting a monitoring activity. Following the conference there will be a three day field trip to the Sierra de Batoruco to see endemic birds.
