Biology of Marine Birds, with 19 chapters written by well known authorities, provides the first comprehensive summary of information about marine birds. It summarizes and analyzes information on their breeding biology, ecology, taxonomy, demography, evolution, fossil history, physiology, energetics, and conservation. Four orders of marine birds are covered in detail: (1) penguins (Sphenisciformes), (2) albatross, shearwaters, petrels (Procellariiformes), (3) pelicans, boobies, frigatebirds, tropicbirds, cormorants (Pelecaniformes), and (4) gulls, terns, guillemots (Charadriiformes; Families Laridae and Alcidae). Two summary chapters address the biology of shorebirds and wading birds and their lives in the marine environment. It is a very comprehensive book and numerous summary tables present detailed information on various aspects of seabird life histories, breeding biology, physiology and energetics, and demography. There are extensive references at the end of each chapter. Three chapters dealing with conservation issues will be very useful for land managers.
